

Code of Conduct

Free of harassment – This event should be a harassment-free experience for everyone, regardless of gender, gender identity and expression, age, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, race, ethnicity, religion (or lack thereof), or technology choices. We do not tolerate harassment of any form.

Harassment includes offensive verbal comments related to gender, gender identity and expression, age, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, race, ethnicity, religion, technology choices, deliberate intimidation, stalking, following, harassing photography or recording, sustained disruption of talks or other events, inappropriate physical contact, and unwelcome sexual attention.

Confidentiality – No personal stories or specific information that may identify a person should be shared unless consent has been obtained beforehand in writing via email.

Considerate, non-judgemental and respectful – Participants need to be patient and be non-judgmental towards different ideas, expressions and opinions. All interactions need to be respectful, also when sharing different or opposing opinions and when disagreeing.

Use of images / Consent – The use of images of people in the event without their explicit written consent is prohibited. In the case you notice an image in an inappropriate space or context, please contact safechoice@rutgers.nl.
